

Tsefalen Tablets



Tsefalen Tablets are indicated for the treatment of infections of the respiratory system, urogenital system and skin, localised infections in soft tissue, and gastrointestinal infections caused by cefalexin-sensitive bacteria.

Tsefalen Tablets are non-flavoured tablets so are the ideal antibiotic because it will not interfere with food trails or cause a reaction in food sensitive dogs.

Available as scored 500mg and a 1000mg tablets, dosing is easier at the dermatologist recommended dose of 25mg/kg with fewer tablets needed per dose.

Composition:

Cephalexin Monohydrate in film-coated tablets

How to use

- 15mg/kg twice a day or 25mg/kg in severe or acute conditions
- Use for at least 3 weeks for deep pyoderma + 3 weeks post resolution

Tsefalen Granular Solution



Tsefalen Granular is the first and only cephalexin in oral suspension form for cats and small-medium sized dogs. Tsefalen Granular is for the treatment of infections caused by bacteria susceptible to cephalexin for the following:

*Dogs:
skin (deep pyoderma) respiratory system urogenital system gastrointestinal system soft tissue system*

*Cats:
skin (deep pyoderma) urogenital system gastrointestinal system soft tissue system*

Tsefalen Granular can be administered directly into the mouth with the supplied syringe or mixed into food, making it ideal for animals who are difficult to pill.

Composition:

One ml of reconstituted oral suspension contains:

Active substance:

Cefalexin (as cefalexin monohydrate) 50 mg
(equivalent to cefalexin monohydrate 52.6 mg)

How to use

- 15mg/kg twice a day or 25mg/kg in severe or acute conditions
- Use for at least 3 weeks for deep pyoderma + 3 weeks post resolution

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
