### Tsefalen Tablets



Tsefalen Tablets are indicated for the treatment of infections of the respiratory system, urogenital system and skin, localised infections in soft tissue, and gastrointestinal infections caused by cefalexinsensitive bacteria.

Tsefalen Tablets are non-flavoured tablets so are the ideal antibiotic because it will not interfere with food trails or cause a reaction in food sensitive dogs.

Available as scored 500mg and a 1000mg tablets, dosing is easier at the dermatologist recommended dose of 25mg/kg with fewer tablets needed per dose.

#### **Composition:**

Cephalexin Monohydrate in film-coated tablets

#### How to use

- 15mg/kg twice a day or 25mg/kg in severe or acute conditions
- Use for at least 3 weeks for deep pyoderma + 3 weeks post resolution

### Tsefalen Granular Solution





Tsefalen Granular is the first and only cephalexin in oral suspension form for cats and small-medium sized dogs. Tsefalen Granular is for the treatment of infections caused by bacteria susceptible to cephalexin for the following:

#### Dogs:

skin (deep pyoderma) respiratory system urogenital system gastrointestinal system soft tissue system

#### Cats:

skin (deep pyoderma) urogenital system gastrointestinal system soft tissue system

Tsefalen Granular can be administered directly into the mouth with the supplied syringe or mixed into food, making it ideal for animals who are difficult to pill.

#### **Composition:**

One ml of reconstituted oral suspension contains:

Active substance:

Cefalexin (as cefalexin monohydrate)50 mg (equivalent to cefalexin monohydrate 52.6 mg)

#### How to use

- 15mg/kg twice a day or 25mg/kg in severe or acute conditions
- Use for at least 3 weeks for deep pyoderma + 3 weeks post resolution
