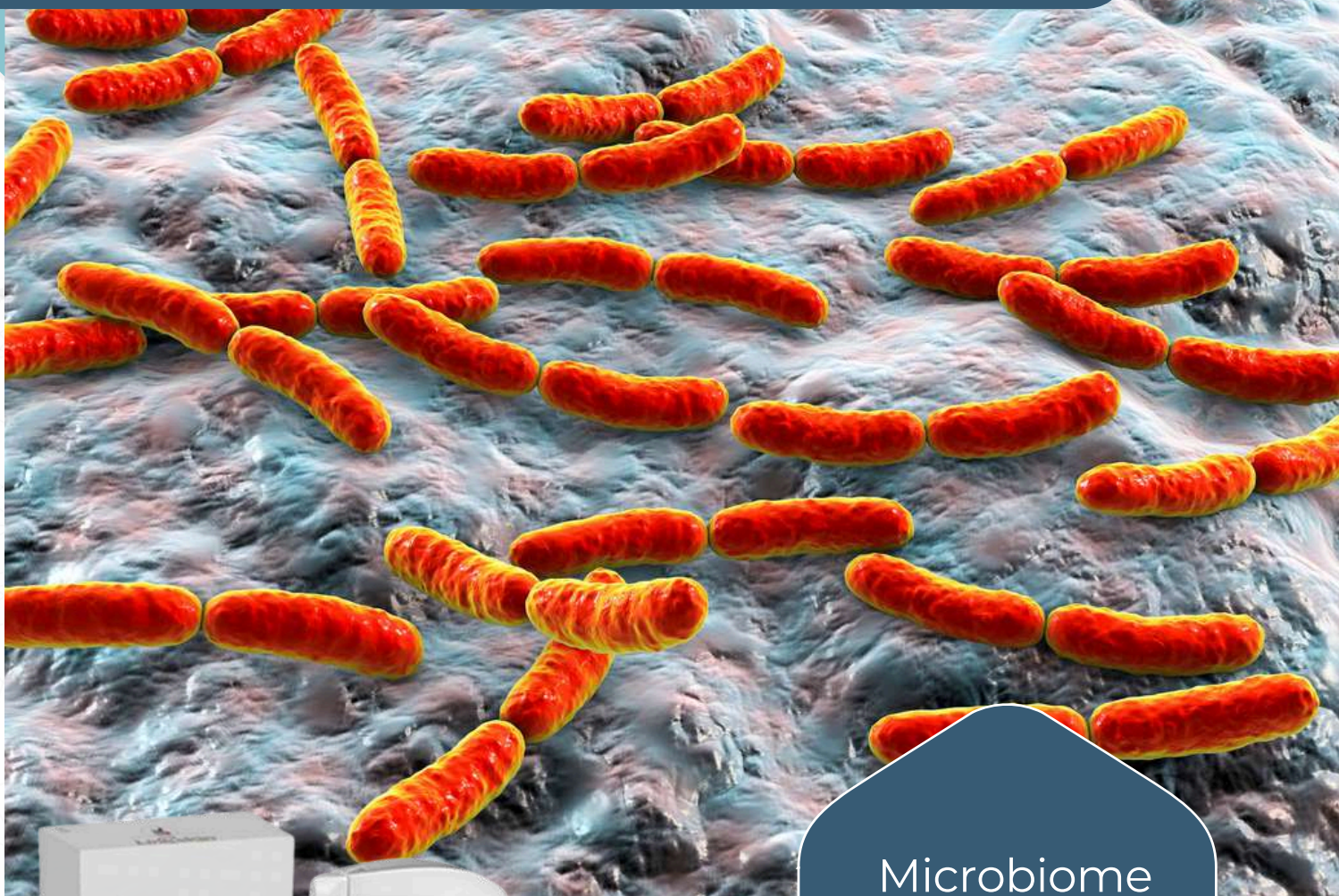

6. Use for at least 15 days



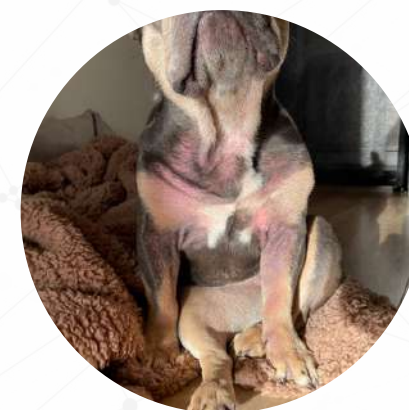
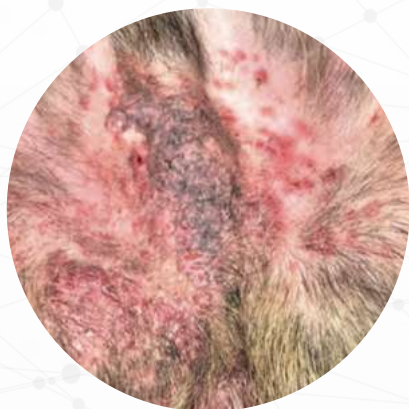
